

## Proposed By-Law Changes

The Windward Artists Guild Board approved these changes for presentation to the membership. Please read them carefully and be prepared to vote on them at the short general meeting on December 5, 2004. Current language to be repealed is bracketed and struck through [-] New language is underscored.

### Article VI.

Section 3. A quorum of the Board shall be one half of the total members of the Board, plus one member. Whenever an elective or appointive officer (other than the president) is temporarily unable to perform the duties of such office, the president may appoint an acting officer for the period of the temporary vacancy.

In the absence of a quorum the meeting shall be adjourned.

Section 5. [~~A quarter~~] One-tenth of the membership shall constitute a quorum at any general or special meeting. A simple majority of the members present and voting is required to pass any motion not involving by-law changes.

Section 7. Voting by members may be by proxy in such form and by such methods as the Board of Directors may specify from time to time.
