

WINDWARD ARTISTS GUILD

2005 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Windward Artists Guild is the sponsor of this scholarship program. The Windward Artists Guild, founded in 1960, is dedicated to furthering the creation of visual art. With this goal in mind, the Windward Artists Guild grants this scholarship to a full-time college student residing on the Windward side of Oahu (Kahuku to Waimanalo), who is pursuing a degree in visual art. The \$500 scholarship will be awarded during the 2005 spring semester. The scholarship will include a one-year student membership in the guild. The scholarship winner agrees to show an example of work at one of the next Windward Artists Guild exhibits. This work will not be part of the juried show.

The Windward Artists Guild board will decide the winner of this scholarship on the basis of the submitted application, portfolio, and instructor recommendation.

Eligibility criteria:

1. The applicant must reside on the Windward side of Oahu (Kahuku to Waimanalo).
2. The applicant must be a full-time student in a visual arts degree program at a college or university on Oahu.
3. The student should have a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0.
4. An eligible student will have successfully completed at least one art class, and will be enrolled in at least one art class during the spring semester.

To apply:

1. Complete both sides of this application.
2. Include a letter of recommendation from a college/university art instructor.
3. Include college verification of grades and of full-time status.
4. Show a portfolio of at least five and no more than ten original art pieces that you have created.
